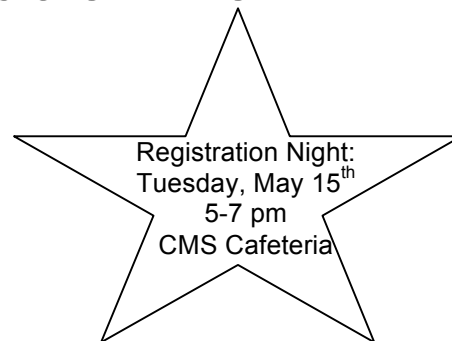

Behavior Code:

Swimmers and parents will submit to the authority of WVSSL Board members, team administrators, coaches and any on duty lifeguards when involved in any WVSSL event. Violation may result in immediate expulsion from the event.

WVSSL Board members, team administrators, coaches and parents will work to promote good sportsmanship and teamwork amongst WVSSL participants. WVSSL Board members, team administrators and coaches may determine what behaviors challenge good sportsmanship and teamwork.

Swimmers and parents will not behave in ways that interfere with the participation of, or threaten the safety of, any other person during WVSSL events. WVSSL Board members, team administrators and coaches may determine what constitutes interfering or threatening behavior.

During WVSSL events, swimmers may not use or possess tobacco. During WVSSL events, no person may use or possess illegal drugs; illegally use prescription drugs; use non-prescription drugs or herbal remedies for purposes other than their published indications at other than the recommended dosages.
